## HOW TO FIND YOUR TAX INFORMATION

### What is Adjusted Gross Income?

Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) is defined as gross income minus adjustments to income. Gross income includes your wages, dividends, capital gains, business income, unemployment compensation, rental income, retirement distributions as well as other income. Adjustments to Income include such items as Educator expenses, Student loan interest, Alimony payments or contributions to a retirement account. Your AGI will never be more than your Gross Total Income on your return and, in some cases, may be lower.

### If you file your taxes by mail

Various versions of Form 1040 reflect the AGI amount on different lines:

Line 8b on [Form 1040](#) and 1040-SR (on tax year 2019 form)

- Line 11 on [Form 1040](#) and 1040-SR (on tax year 2020 form)
- Line 11 on Form 1040NR (on tax year 2020 form)

You can find the name of your tax form on the upper left-hand corner of your return.

### If you e-file your taxes

If you used online tax software such as TurboTax, TaxSlayer, H&R Block, or TaxAct, to e-file your taxes, you can typically login to and download a copy of prior year's 1040 tax return to find your AGI.

### If you don't currently have access to your tax records

You can request a transcript of your tax records directly from the IRS. You can access this information online or by mail.

Request Tax Return Transcript Online

Visit the IRS website at

- Select "Get Transcript Online" (You will have to set up an account)
- Follow instructions to obtain your "Tax Return Transcript". You will be able to immediately view, print, or download your tax return transcript.

Request Tax Return Transcript by Mail

Visit the IRS website at

<https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript>

- Select "Get Transcript by Mail"
- Follow instructions to request by mail and your Tax Return Transcript will be mailed to you within 10 days

### 2020 – Your AGI is on line 11
