


How To Find your Federal IRS Determination Letter

NOTE: If you are applying with a fiscal sponsor, please instead ask your fiscal sponsor for a copy of their IRS Determination Letter.


1. Go to the [IRS's Search for Tax Exempt Organizations](https://apps.irs.gov/app/eos) (https://apps.irs.gov/app/eos).

Under "Select Database", choose "Determination Letters".




